# Valley County Pickleball Club

## Dinking Tournament

**O**n July 11, the Valley County Pickleball Club will be hosting a dinking tournament at the Donnelly City Courts.

Unlike last Saturday's ladder tournament, you will need to enter the dinking tournament with a partner.

The entry fee is \$5 per team. This will be a round robin tournament in which you will play all the teams in your division. We may have an upper division and a lower division depending on the number of teams that participate.

The winner will be the team with the most wins (1st tie breaker is head to head, 2nd tie breaker is most total points scored, 3rd tiebreaker is least points allowed).

Teams can be mixed, women's or men's. Two 4.0 or higher level players cannot play together on the same team.



You do not have to be the fastest, strongest or best pickleball player to be a good dinker. Anybody could win this tournament. It will be fun. Most importantly, the more you practice dinking, the better pickleball player you will become.
