HOBBLE CREEK PARK PICKLEBALL COMPLEX UPDATE JULY 2018

Some of you may have heard that the Treasure Valley Pickleball Advocates have met our financial obligation for the Hobbble Creek Park Pickleball Complex. Our partner, the Boise Parks and Recreation Department, plan to begin construction of the complex in 2019.

There remain options that pickleball advocates can exercise to contribute to the complex. Brick sales will go on for some time at \$100 and \$200 each. Please contact Nick and Tami Leach at tamileach@gmail.com to purchase a brick.

Pickleball courts can be purchased for \$6,000 each that will forever identify the donors with a plaque at the gate of that court. At this time we have sold three courts. There are presently ten committed advocates who have donated \$500 each for court number four. Once we identify two more advocates to complete that court purchase, we have a possible donor who has indicated interest in purchasing the fifth court. In addition the water fountain can be sponsored for \$4,000. The donations for the courts and drinking fountain must be paid by October 1, 2018. Donations are tax deductible through our 501(c)(3).
