

Play the game you love with the one you love! The Boise Area Pickleball Association (BAPA) is hosting an indoor, round-robin tournament at Eagle Tennis Club located in Eagle, Idaho.

Eagle Tennis Club is a premium location for an indoor tournament. This year-round climate controlled facility has 12 permanently marked pickleball courts, a floating mezzanine for excellent viewing, fitness facility, showers, and dining area.

A portion of the proceeds of this tournament will be donated to The American Heart Association.

Social Play: Friday evening 6-9 pm, February 15, 2019 with food and soft drinks included with registration. Beer and wine available. Saturday evening open play after competition events.

Events: Men's and Women's Doubles on Saturday, February 16, 2019. Mixed Doubles on Sunday, February 17, 2019.

Format: Skill-based Round Robin play with two age divisions: 12+ and 60+. Age divisions could be combined, and Skill levels may be combined ONLY to build a large enough bracket.

Skill levels: 2.5 - 5.0

Cost: \$50 registration (Per Player) which includes the first event. \$10.00 for second event.

Giveaways: Paddles, hats, bags and other pickleball swag

Registration limits: Men's: 30 teams; Women's: 25 teams; Mixed: 60 teams
The date of the LATTER player to register & pay online will determine the team's registration date and place on the team limit list. Therefore, entry of the team is not complete until BOTH team members create their online registrations, sign waivers & pay their fees.
All fees and waivers must be submitted by February 6, 2019.

Time: Players will be notified of the time to checkin when brackets and seedings are completed.

Balls: We will be using Onix Fuse pickleballs in yellow for brackets 2.5 - 3.5 and Dura Fast 40 pickleballs in yellow for brackets 4.0 and above.

Hobble Creek Park Pickleball Complex Update

HOBBLE CREEK PARK PICKLEBALL COMPLEX UPDATE
DECEMBER 5, 2018

At this time of year Treasure Valley Pickleball Advocates have a lot to be proud of and thankful for.

On October 31, 2018 the Hobble Creek Park Pickleball Complex Committee delivered a check to the Boise Parks and Recreation Department (BPRD). That check satisfied our \$50,000 obligation to BPRD. With our financial obligation secure along with a contribution from our corporate partner the J.A. and Kathryn Albertson Family Foundation, the BPRD will apply for the Land and Water Conservation Grant in order to generate the additional revenue necessary to complete the Hobble Creek Park Pickleball Complex. Once the grant is approved, BPRD plan to begin construction in the early summer of 2019 with completion scheduled for September.

There are donors that have stepped up to support the sport of pickleball in the Treasure Valley. Several pickleball advocates have combined to purchase courts, as have businesses (see page 2). We want to thank and support Idaho Pizza for their generous donation.

There are still several courts that can be sponsored and the water fountain is still available for a \$4,000 donation. Additional supporters will provide needed revenue to develop infrastructure amenities that will make the complex a beautiful, inclusive and welcoming venue.
